Terminology	Definition
Introductory Business Core Course	Students must complete a 6UOC (1 course) of Introductory Business core course.
Economics Core Courses	Students must complete 48UOC (8 courses) of level 1 and 2 Economics Core Courses.
Economics Electives	Students must complete 30UOC (5 courses) of Economics electives or accepted substitutes of Economics electives to ensure a student completes a minimum of 78 UOC (13 courses) of Economics courses across the program.
Optional Economics Majors	Students may wish to complete an optional Economics major(s) (ECONV1, ECONT1, ECONU1). If students do not complete an optional Economics major(s), students will complete program with a default major by completing program requirements. If you choose to study 2 optional Economics majors, you must choose another 36UOC (6 courses) from the second major that do not overlap with the first major.
Business School Electives	Students must complete a minimum 12UOC (2 courses) of courses within the Business School. Students are free to use these UOC to complete courses from the Business School, however they need to be mindful of the program level 1 limit when making their selection. GEN courses cannot count as Business School electives.
Free Electives	Free Electives account for 36UOC (6 courses) to satisfy the degree requirement of 144UOC (24 courses). These courses may be taken from the Business School or other Faculties. GEN coded courses cannot be counted as free electives. You may choose to use these Free Electives and Business School Electives to complete a second Business major or minor. Free Elective courses can also be used to complete an optional approved minor from other faculties.
General Education	Account for 12UOC (2 courses) and are to be taken outside the UNSW Business School. Please note that students enrolled in programs within the UNSW Business School cannot take General Education courses offered by the UNSW Business School (i.e., GENC code). These restrictions also apply to the following courses: GENL2021 An Introduction to the Australian Legal System, GENL2032 Cyberspace Law 2.0.
Maximum Majors/Minors	Students may complete up to 2 majors or 1 major and 1 minor within their program. E.g., Default Economics major and Accounting major, or Macroeconomics and Financial Markets major and Finance minor, or default Economics major and Statistics minor. Note: Students cannot complete both a default major and an optional Economics major. However, can complete 2 optional Economics majors.
Level 1 limit	The maximum level one limit in this degree is 60UOC (10 courses), excluding General Education courses.
Overall Program UOC	Students must complete a minimum 144 UOC (24 courses) across program requirements.
