LLB Admission Review

- Admission to the LLB at UNSW is currently under review. As a result, the 2025 Law Admission Test (LAT) will only be open to students seeking admission in 2026.
- Results are still valid for the Year 11 students who sat the LAT in 2024 and can be used for entry in 2026.

New BCCJ Double Degree Combinations

Develop a deep understanding of human behaviour and the criminal justice system by combining two of UNSW's highly regarded degrees. Students will gain real world perspectives into crime, deviance, social control and the legal system, along with an understanding of the brain, cognitive and decision-making processes and mental health.

Bachelor of Criminology & Criminal Justice / Bachelor Psychological Science



- 2025 lowest selection rank: **83**
- 4 years full time
- Two intakes per year – term 1 and term 3

Bachelor of Criminology & Criminal Justice / Psychology (Honours)



- 2025 lowest selection rank: **98**
- 5 years full time
- One intake a year – Term 1 intake only

Market Response: T1 2025 Uptake
