Extension components, Specialisation-specific and Prescribed Electives can be taken in any Term that they are offered.

- *Students may replace up to 12 UOC of Specialisation Electives with a Project or Internship. Please check the eligibility requirements for Projects and the Internship before discussing with your Program Authority. Internships are offered in Terms 1 and 3 only.
- # Students can choose between an additional Elective, research Project, Independent Study, or Internship.
