#The Extension component is either:

*ID, GH, and Prescribed Electives, as well as the Extension components, can be taken in any Term that they are offered. Students may replace up to 12 UOC of Prescribed Electives with an Independent study or Internship. Please check the eligibility requirements for an Independent Study or Internship before discussing with your Program Authority. Internships are offered in Terms 1 and 3 only.

'All School of Population Health postgraduate program students who completed their previous studies in a non-<u>English speaking country</u> are required to take <u>PHCM9100 Academic Practice</u> in their first term. The course is worth 0 units of credit, is not counted in your study load, and there are no tuition fees to be paid.
