Lateral Entry domestic students enter the 3805 program in Phase 2 Year 3 (Clinical Courses) after completing the Graduate Bridging course (MFAC2510) during the Summer/MS1 term.

Students must pass all course requirements (MFAC2514, MFAC2515, MFAC2516), the Phase 2 examination (MFAC2512) and the Phase 2 Portfolio (MFAC2511) in order to progress.

NOTES

Successful students will join Phase 3 Year 5 the following year and continue through to Year 6.

#### Phase 2 Clinical Coursework

Phase 2 students will enrol in the following courses during Year 3:

- MFAC2514, Integrated Clinical Studies 1 in M1A (T1)
- MFAC2515, Integrated Clinical Studies 2 in MT2 (T2)
- MFAC2516, Integrated Clinical Studies 3 in M3A (T3)

Students complete six sub-courses within MFAC2514, MFAC2515, & MFAC2516 in the respective teaching periods. The sub-courses will be completed in a distinct order based on their individually assigned Sequence.

The sub-courses are:

- 1. Adult Health 1 (Adult 1)
- 2. Adult Health 2 (Adult 2)
- 3. Birth, Growth and Development (BGD)
- 4. Oncology and Palliative Care (O&PC)
- 5. Society and Health (S&H)
- 6. Aged Care (AC&R)

Students must also enrol into: **MFAC2510** in **MS1** (Graduate Entry Bridging course), **MFAC2511** in **M3A** (Phase 2 Portfolio Examination), and **MFAC2512** in **T3B** (Phase 2 Integrated Clinical Assessment).
