


Navigating the CyberPolicyHub

 Go to MyCyberHub and select CyberPolicyHub from the top menu bar.



2. Search for relevant Cyber Security clauses

- a) Make your selection using the filters:
 - Risk Rating
 - Topic
 - Related Roles
 - Asset Type
- b) Once you select the appropriate filters, relevant subcauses will be shown in the table.




To save the search results as a PDF

a) Select the Export icon.
