  - Social Sciences Honours course ARTS4266 Puzzles, Planning, and Presentation
- \*\*ATSI4003 Research Design in Indigenous Studies may be substituted with ARTS4249 Advances in the Humanities
- Note: ATSI4003 / ARTS4249 (12uoc) is taught as a multi-term course at 6 UOC each term

## ^30uoc Thesis or Project:
