

# Bachelor of Arts/Education (Secondary) 4053



## Term 1 2025 Commencing Students

The Bachelor of Arts/Education is a four-year program for students intending to become secondary school teachers in one or two of the available teaching areas.

Students complete the Arts (96uoc) and the Education component (96uoc).

The courses the student completes as part of their Major and Minor in the Arts, will form the 'subject content' for their chosen teaching area(s).
