The Bachelor of Education (Primary) is an undergraduate initial teacher education program developed in partnership with the New South Wales Education Standards Authority.

The program will be accredited by the NSW Education Standards Authority (NESA), enabling graduates to teach in both government and non-government primary schools in all states of Australia and overseas.

The program supports students to meet the Australian Professional Standards for Teachers at graduate level. Academic lecturers and local teachers with experience in primary education work together to provide core education courses and discipline-specific curriculum and pedagogy studies within the six key learning areas of the primary curriculum:

•English

Mathematics

Science and Technology

History and Geography

•Creative Arts

•Personal Development, Health and Physical Education
