1. Prescribed Electives

Students must select four elective courses (24 UOC) from the Prescribed Elective list and can complete them in any term, not just as shown above. Students wishing to graduate with a **City Analytics** or **Urban Design** specialisation should choose their electives from those listed under the specialisations. 2. Sustainability core course

SUSD0004 Sustainability and Habitability, offered in Term 3, is an accepted equivalent to SUSD0001. This also gives more flexibility on elective choice.
