


















4 Do you do ...?








 (No,) I don't know how to ... (아니요,) ... (으)ㄴ 줄 몰라요.

To give a little bit more than just the 'Yes' or 'No' answers above, you might want to answer

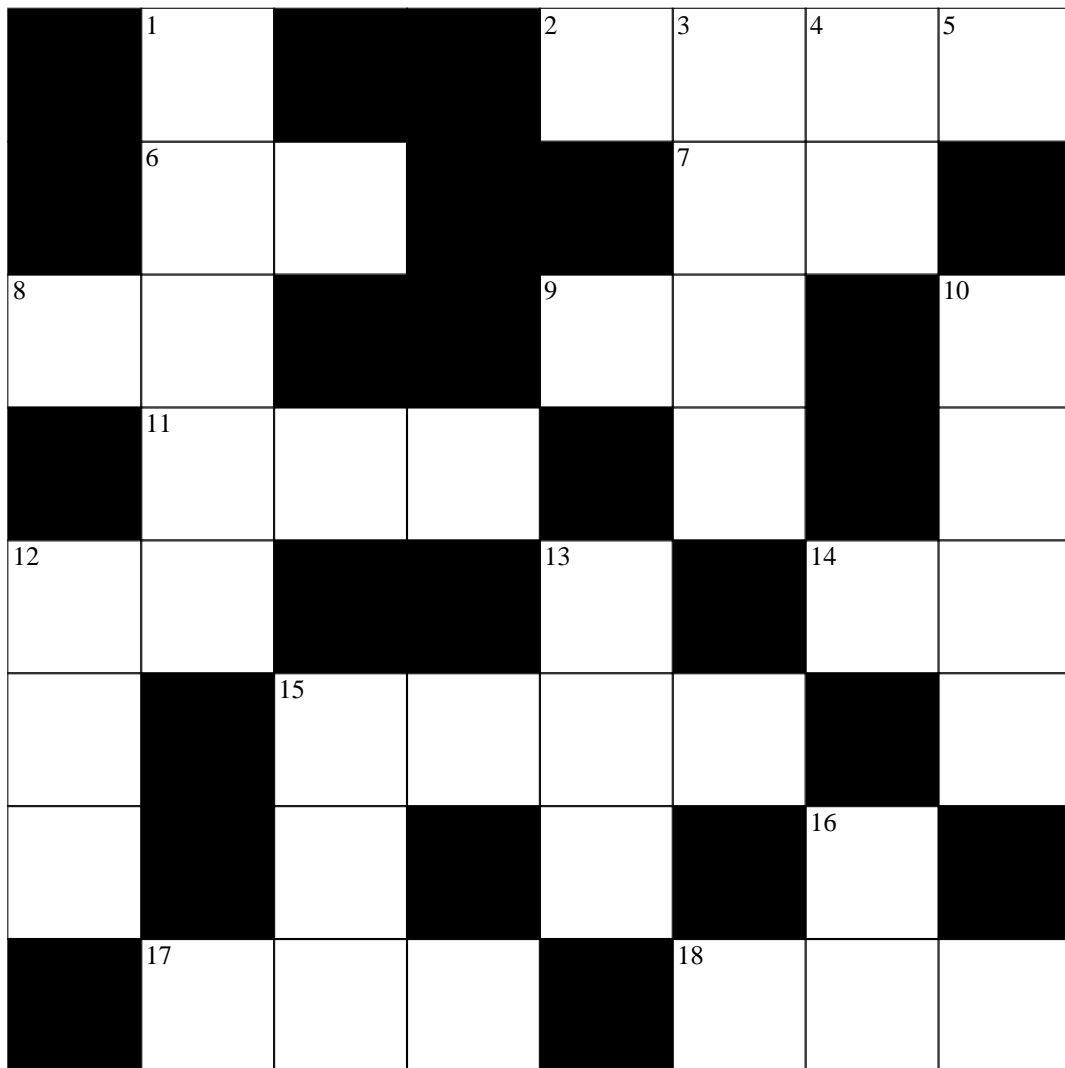
