Terminology	Definition
<b>Program compulsory core &amp; flexible core courses</b>	Courses which students must complete under their enrolled degree e.g. Bachelor of Commerce Co-op 3554  Two streams of study will be possible within the BCom (Co-op*): Stream A - General stream or Stream B - Honours stream.
<b>Commerce Co-op Major</b>	Students complete a major (48UOC) in the disciplinary area of their Co-op scholarship. The major must contain at least 18 UOC at level 3. (Note that the 48UOC includes the first disciplinary course(s) in the Core (Compulsory or Flexible). This means that, for the majority of majors, students will complete 42UOC in specified disciplinary courses outside the core.) Students may complete another major within an approved area of study within the UNSW Business School or other Faculty if studying under Stream A.
<b>Industrial Training Experience</b>	These courses account for 36 UOC. <b>Students complete 3 industrial training experience courses within the area of their co-op scholarship, with each course worth 12 UOC.</b>
<b>UNSW Business School Elective</b>	0-12UOC in UNSW Business School courses to ensure a student completes a minimum of 132UOC of Business courses within the BCom (Co-op). The exact number of courses to complete will depend on the Co-op major chosen.
<b>Second major or Free Electives or Honours courses</b>	Stream A- General Stream students can use the Free Electives to complete courses from any Faculty or study courses to form a second major, however they need to be mindful of the program limit on Level 1 courses (60 UOC) when making their selection.  Stream B- Honours Stream students will complete 48 UOC for the Honours streams, any remaining UOC will become Free electives, however they need to be mindful of the program limit on Level 1 courses (60 UOC) when making their selection.  GEN courses cannot count as Free elective.
<b>General Education</b>	Account for 12UOC (2 courses) and are to be taken outside the UNSW Business School. Please note that students enrolled in programs within the UNSW Business School cannot take General Education courses offered by the UNSW Business School (i.e. GENC code). These restrictions also apply to the following courses: GENL2015 The World of Work; GENL2021 An Introduction to the
